What are Cookies?

Cookies are files that are downloaded in your computer automatically when you access some websites. Cookies allow a website to store and recover information about the browsing preferences of a certain user or of his computer.

How can I disable cookies in the main browsers?

Normally it is possible to stop accepting the browser's Cookies, or to stop accepting the Cookies of a specific service. All modern browsers provide users with the option of changing Cookies configuration. These settings can be found under the browser's 'options' or 'preferences'. Although the steps and names may vary slightly between different versions of different browsers, these are the steps to manage Cookies configuration in the main browsers:

- **Internet Explorer:** Tools -> Internet Options -> Privacy -> Settings.
- **Firefox:** Tools -> Options -> Privacy -> History -> Use Custom Settings for History.
- **Chrome:** Settings -> Show advanced options -> Privacy -> Content settings.
- **Safari:** Preferences-> Security
